**Galveston Bike Rally RV Parking  
Seahorse Lot**

- Cost –
  - \$75 Per night for RV Parking (Tax Inclusive)
  - \$10 Per day for passenger vehicles
    - All Reservations must be made through Sunday.
    - Sunday overnight available
    - Checkout is 12:00pm on Sunday and or Monday
- Parking Space Rules
  - Spaces are approximately 20' x 40'.
    - Trucks with a pull-behind or an RV with a Trailer that is longer than 50' will be required to purchase two parking spaces.
  - Spaces are grass surface.
  - You are issued 1 placard for your RV or pull-behind. (Placard not transferable)
  - Only one tow pass per space is allowed.
    - A tow vehicle is defined as any passenger vehicle which can be driven, or any single / double-axle trailer. All tow vehicles must fit on your purchased space at all times. (Tow Pass not transferable)
    - Tow pass vehicle or trailer must enter with the RV or Pull Behind in order to claim a Tow Pass. If not, the vehicle or trailer will be charged as an additional vehicle at \$10 per day through Sunday.
  - All RVs / Pull Behinds and Passenger Vehicles must remain in your purchased space at all times.
- Parking Lot Rules
  - Vehicles should remain locked at all times
  - Landry's is not responsible for fire, theft, damage or loss
    - Don't leave valuables unattended or doors unlocked
  - Please respect your neighbor's space and don't cut through campsites, walk around campsites.
  - No Dumping
  - No Open Flames
  - No loud music or excessive noise
  - Parking pass / placard must be displayed at all times
  - Speed Limit – 10mph
  - Guests shall be responsible for cleanup of all debris and return the lot to its original condition
  - Keep your pets on a leash at all times and remember to clean up after them. Please respect your neighbor's space and make sure your pets do as well.
  - The owner reserves the right to make and enforce all rules deemed necessary for the safety, comfort and enjoyment of guests staying overnight.
    - Please report campground issues to the campground host or security guard as soon as possible.
